

Details from The Wild Lily Institute Est. 2005

The Wild Lily Institute was founded in 2005, received its formal name and became a legal entity in 2008 (the Emily Isaacson Institute), then changed its name in 2016 to WLI.

"Then the garden of your soul will bloom . . ."

The Wild Lily Institute is a member of the Fraser Valley Poets Society, the Mission Arts Council (MAC), and Abbotsford Restorative Justice and Advocacy Association.

Emily Isaacson published her first book in 2007 (a children's book), and now has 15 books out.

The WLI has approximately 4,000 books in print by Emily Isaacson.

We have 53 poetry and art videos on YouTube with 4,654 views.

Emily Isaacson was in a documentary on television in Europe (made in 1995).

We have put over 50,000 ads on television in the USA.

We have put over 9 million ads on the Google network.

We have put 84,285 ads on Facebook.

Emily Isaacson has over 13,000 fans on MySpace.

WLI pages have over 2826 likes on Facebook.

The WLI has attracted over 1, 429, 167 visits to its websites according to our stats.

We average over 700 visitors a day this year.

Our blogs have 29, 904 page views.

We have 5376 social media friends and contacts.

We send out 385 cards and letters for Christmas.

Emily Isaacson has received seven Christmas cards from the Royal Family, one from the Prime Minister (Harper), two from the Premier (Horgan), and a letter from Prime Minister Justin Trudeau.

Isaacson has been in private practice for 14 years and is the consulting nutritionist for orphanages funded by the Imagine Thailand Foundation.

Over 275 people have been helped by Emily Isaacson with their nutrition.
